- New equipment must be installed and operational within 24 months from date of Notice to Proceed
- All equipment in the fleet must be in compliance with regulatory requirements

- Usage records with hour meter readings for twelve
  (12) consecutive months from 2019 or later;
- o CARB approval of new equipment as zero-emission;
- CARB Executive Order(s) for existing engine(s); and
- Itemized quotes for new zero-emission equipment and infrastructure.
